- c.) 2023 Minor Funding Opportunities. The FCSS Coordinator received further direction on the new application directed at special projects to celebrate Pride and Indigenous Relations events. Directives include; keep application to 2 pages + project budget, include FCSS parameters as it relates to preventative programming, emphasize Pride and Indigenous Relations events as key initiatives, application dates are February 13, 2023 (out to community) and March 13, 2023 application deadline. Board will look at applications on March 20, 2023.

- **d.)** Review of 2023 Meeting dates. The following 2023 dates have been approved; January 16, March 20, April 17, May 15, June 19, October 2, October 16, November 20, and December 18. FCSS Coordinator will add all dates to Board members calendars.
- e.) Pincher Creek & District Food Centre update. Board member Wagenaar provided an update as a Food Centre Board member. Recently two new freezers and stand-up refrigerators have been purchased to help store and then distribute fresh or frozen produce. Seventy-three (approximately) households were served in November 2022, and demand is increasing. The Food Centre recently received an \$8,000 grant.
